



READING AREA WATER AUTHORITY
ESTIMATED READ POLICY

Resolution
2009-3

Be it resolved this 15th day of October, 2009 by the Board of the Reading Area Water Authority ("RAWA") that the following shall be, and is hereby adopted as the official policy of RAWA:

1. Whenever the RAWA renders a make-up bill for previously unbilled water service resulting from either a utility billing error, meter failure, or four or more consecutive estimated readings, RAWA shall allow the period of the payment arrangement at the option of the rate payer to extend for a period not to exceed the estimated read, during which the excess amount accrued period plus six months.
2. When a meter has been found not to have registered for a period or not to have fully measured the entire flow due to meter interference, RAWA shall compute the water usage resulting in an estimated bill.
3. RAWA shall obtain an actual meter reading at least once every (5) Five years to verify the accuracy of the remote reading device.
